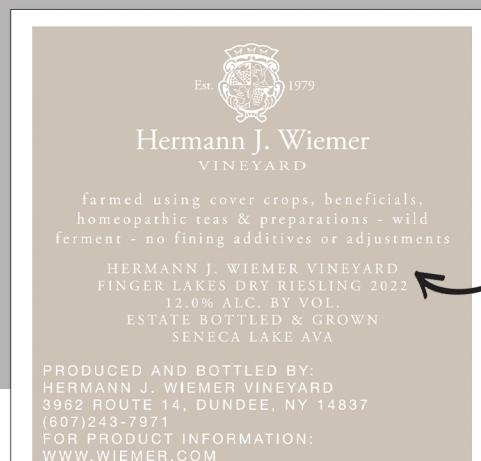

Flower Day Riesling 2022

The Flower Day Riesling is fresh and exuberant in nature, and is dry with an almost playful effervescence. This wine is sleek and crisp with lemony freshness and a pristine wet-stone finish. This wine highlights our commitment to ecosystem health and comprehensive viticulture practices. We adhere to unique farming methods that focus not solely on our vineyards but on the totality of our farm, promoting biodiversity in adjacent fields, forests, and meadows, while utilizing cover crops, beneficials, and homeopathic teas and preparations. On the biodynamic calendar there are four kinds of days: root days, flower days, fruit days, and leaf days. Each of these days has certain tasks associated with it; Fruit days are meant for harvesting, leaf days for watering, root days for pruning. On flower days, the vineyard is left alone and rests.

Farming Method: Biodynamic (in conversion)

Vinification: Whole cluster pressed, indigenous yeast fermentation, aged in 100% stainless steel.

Our Farming & Winemaking Practices

- As of 2004, we eliminated the use of herbicides.
- Our core soil management techniques include the usage of organic compost and cover crops.
- All estate fruit is hand-harvested and hand-sorted.
- Our fermentations rely on indigenous yeasts.
- We do not use fining or filtering additives.
- Our sulfur usage is below certified organic levels (EU standard).
