Keep vines in a moist, cool environment. Do not cut tops or roots. Soak vines for 24 hours before planting.

PLANTING YOUR VINES

- 1. Always keep vine moist during the planting process. Do not allow the roots to dry out.
- 2. Spread roots out to insure that the roots set.
- 3. Heel in vine deep enough so the union can be covered with soil. With young vines, the union is fragile until it becomes established.
- 4. Pack soil around plants to collapse any air pockets.
- 5. Mound soil around top growth untigrowth is apparent. After growth is apparent, this mound should be removed.
